An EBSCOhost database. Publication Dates: 1887 to present. A comprehensive scholarly, multi-disciplinary full-text database, including more than 8,500 full-text periodicals, and more than 7,300 peer-reviewed journals.

SEARCH BY KEYWORD: MONUMENT

•Searching brings up a lot of entries (over 26,000!). How else can you narrow your topic?

•You may want to put in a specific topic by adding another variable:

MONUMENT AND CONFEDERATE

•Now you only have entries that deal with MONUMENT AND CONFEDERATE

You can limit your search further

•Look at the left-hand column to see how you can limit your results by

- •Full Text
- •SCHOLARLY
- •DATE OF PUBLICATION

•Look at the results

•Look at where the articles appear, the number of pages, the **SUBJECT TERMS** and **KEYWORDS** used

•Look at the abstract to see if they will be useful

Note that this is PROQUEST database. This has a very different template for searching, but the concepts are the same.

This database contains the full-text of <u>The New York Times</u>. Newspaper databases help document and chronicle events as they unfold over time. See these are newspaper articles, they will be rather short.

You may want to go back and specifically search VIETNAM AND MEMORIAL AND MAYA LIN FULL TEXT Things to keep in mind when looking at search results from any database: •number of results

•do you need to narrow your search? Add more variables using AND

•do you need to expand your results? Add more variables using OR
•date of publication does it matter when something was published?

•type of publication does it matter whether it is aimed at a scholarly or popular audience?

•language restrictions?

•geographical restrictions?
